#### LYDEARD ST. LAWRENCE CHURCH DEVELOPMENT PROJECT PROGRESS UPDATE

We reported in November last year about our plan to apply for funding for the project. Our bid to the Heritage Lottery was unsuccessful, but they gave us some positive feedback and invited us to apply again.

The Heritage Lottery said that our plan did not hit the mandatory outcome, 'a wider range of people will be involved in heritage' really hard. Our project 'does not make a strong and compelling case that we will reach a wider range of people'.

Our church is a rich source for learning about the traditions, monuments, objects and culture that make up our heritage. We need to connect a wider range of people with this heritage to help justify our bid for funding.

This could mean getting people really involved by giving them training in a new activity connected to the project. Some ideas are woodworking, stonework, landscaping, historic interpretation, film making, all in a conservation environment.

We will be talking to local people and businesses to see what skills are available that could be shared. We can include funding for those doing the training in our lottery bid, so this could be an exciting way of bringing new activities and opportunities to the village.

We are having an open day on Saturday 2 April in the church. Everyone is invited to come and see what is on offer, have some coffee and cake and express an interest.
