Coffee Stop

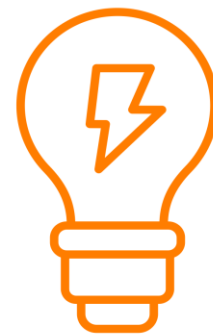
It has been decided that the charges for refreshments in the twice weekly Coffee Stop in the village hall should be updated starting on Monday 20th September.

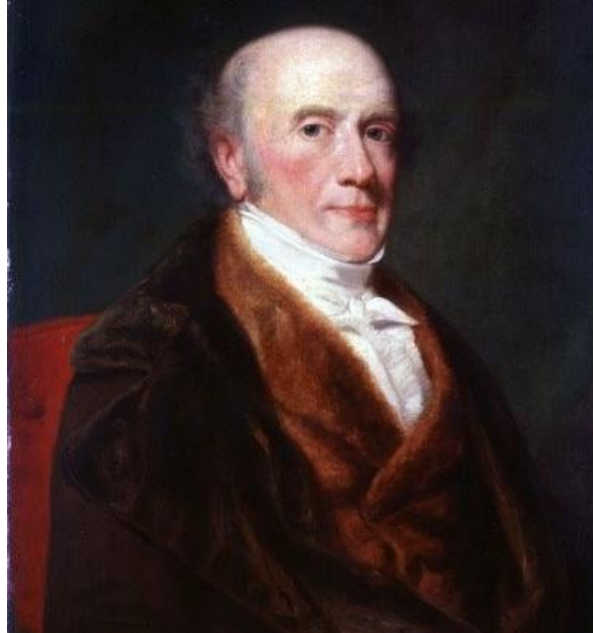
